The Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference will be continuing the MAAC Goodworks Challenge in 2014-15. In 2013-14, the challenge seen its most success with 409 community service events worth 39,428 points, over 2,000 more points than in 2012-13. The MAAC is hoping for an even greater turn out in this year's MAAC Goodworks Challenge.

2014-15 AY MAAC Goodworks Rules & Guidelines

- Timeframe: The start of the 2014-15 AY until April 29th, 2015. **Any submissions prior to the start date and after the end date will not be accounted for in the program.**
- Volunteers may consist of, but are not limited to, students, student-athletes, coaches, school faculty, and administrators. These volunteers will organize, participate in, and document as many community service events as possible in efforts to earn points for the challenge.
- In order to receive points for an event, schools must submit the submission form which must include the names, phone numbers, and hours worked for each volunteer; as well as photos and a brief write-up about the event. Video footage of the event can be submitted for additional points. **All events MUST be submitted within 30 days of the event date in order to receive points.**
- All submissions must be emailed to: hamilton.cook@maac.org (score sheets, write-ups, and photos/videos)
- The MAAC Office is the final authority on whether an event is deserving of points, based on the information provided on the score sheets and photos/videos.
- The schools with the most points on April 29th, 2015 will be the winner of the Challenge.
- Standings will be updated weekly and reports with recently submitted events will go out to membership in the 2014-15 AY.

MAAC Goodworks Awards

All eleven MAAC institutions have an equal opportunity to win the 2014-15 AY MAAC Goodworks Challenge. Marist College won the 2013-14 MAAC Goodworks Challenge and received a \$1,000 donation which they awarded to the Grace Smith House Inc. This year's winner will receive:

- \$1,000 Donation to the charity of its choice.
